### HEEADSSS: A Psychosocial Interview Format for Adolescents

Most adolescents make it through their teenage years and enter adulthood without major trauma However, for some teenagers this may be a very dangerous time of experimentation Social Workers can play an important role in helping with this transition Many social workers find it difficult to discuss sensitive issues with adolescents HEADSSS is a screening tool to assess risks that can be used

### Using Clonidine in Children and Adolescents

Clonidine (Catapres®, Dixarit® and generic forms) belongs to a group of medications called “alpha 2-agonists” It is approved by Health Canada to treat high blood pressure in adults In children and adolescents, this medication may be used for many other conditions, including treatment of attention deficit/hyperactivity disorder (AD/HD) and tic disorders (such as Tourette syndrome) What
