Over the postwar era, for good or ill, the US has seen an explosive surge in both arrests and felony sentencing for our adult population Like it or not, this is a plain fact of life In 2016, 110 million Americans had an arrest record with police authorities⁵ That is over twice as many people as in 1997 (when the total was 54 million⁶) and works out to 44 percent of our adult population⁷
